If you are selected as a camper for July 2017, you will receive an acceptance packet by June 15, 2017. There is a scholarship available for those in financial need. Scholarship applications are posted on the FSWNYS website.

Important notes/requirements: *Only applicants who have not previously attended Phoenix Firecamp are eligible to apply. Applicants must have turned 14 years old by June 1, 2017 and must have completed the 8th grade in order to be eligible. Applicants must not have reached their 20th birthday by July 14, 2017 in order to meet the age requirement. **All applicants must be covered by and provide proof of medical insurance.***

Phoenix Firecamp is a remarkable, week-long training opportunity and is one of only a few such programs in the United States and Canada. The training is valuable, yet intense. The day starts with a wake-up call at 6 a.m. 16 hours later, lights go out at 10 p.m. In order to maintain a safe and productive environment, proper rest between these hours is vital. For this reason, Phoenix Firecamp limits use of cellphones to designated personal times only. Parents are welcome to use the Phoenix Firecamp number in order to contact their child during the week.

Campers 17 years and under are required to be transported to and from Phoenix Firecamp by a responsible adult. Only campers 18 and older are allowed to keep a vehicle on the Academy grounds. Phoenix Firecamp is a closed campus and campers, regardless of age, are not permitted to leave the training grounds or residence facilities without staff supervision. Parents and/or guardians and additional family members are highly encouraged to attend the Graduation Ceremony on Friday afternoon at the conclusion of Phoenix Firecamp.

Donations to Phoenix Firecamp: Phoenix Firecamp is a project of the Fire Service Women of New York State, a nonprofit statewide organization committed to supporting women in fire and emergency services. Phoenix Firecamp is staffed by volunteer and career female firefighters, EMTs, and paramedics. All staff members pay their own expenses and use personal time to make Phoenix Firecamp possible.
